

Christ the Wisdom and Power of God!...1Corinthians 1:18-31 & 2:1-5

⁴¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith." Romans 1:16-17 (ESV)

- 1. Who is the Fool?... Where does your wisdom come from? Scripture... <u>1Corinthians 1:18-21</u>
- 2. Christ Crucified... Simply explained...yet understandably hard to fathom! Scripture... <u>1Corinthians 1:22-23</u>

3. You Have Been Called... Consider your calling! Scripture... <u>1Corinthians 1:24-28</u>

- He is our Wisdom...Colossians 2:3
- He is our Righteousness...2 Corinthians 5:21
- He is our Sanctification...John 17:19
- He is our Redeemer...Romans 3:24

4. If You're Goin to Boast... Give Him the Glory! Scripture... <u>1Corinthians 1:29-31</u>

5. *Proclaiming Christ Crucified...* Don't overthink it, follow Paul's example! Scripture... <u>1Corinthians 2:1-5</u> Discussion 1. What stood out to you in tonight's message and scripture passages? ...be descriptive!

2. We live in a world where people believe that whatever makes you feel good is acceptable. Unfortunately for us, while Christ Crucified is where our Joy comes from, this can be unacceptable to the unbeliever. How do you "Stand Firm" against those who come against you for your belief in a Savior that died for you? Do you tend to hide your faith to hide your foolishness from? Give an example of your experiences...good or bad, so others in your group can be sharpened.

- 3. There are many reasons and excuses why the unbeliever choses to reject Christ. Take a moment to share one of your reasons for rejecting Christ prior to your conversion. Today, as a believer, what do you hear from unbelievers as to why they don't believe the Gospel? What is your approach in helping them with their unbelief? Is it effective? Why or Why not?
- 4. God shows his wisdom by means of the theological words listed below. Discuss the special meaning these words carry for you as a Christian?
 - Righteousness 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - Sanctification John 17:19
 - Redemption Romans 3:24
- 5. Is there anything from tonight's discussion that spoke to you personally? In what way(s) does it affect your life? How will you directly and specifically apply it in your life today?
