JESUS CALMS THE SEA - MARK 4:35-41

HEBREWS 11:10 - Abraham was confidently looking forward to a city with eternal foundations, a city designed and built by God.

II. THE GALILEAN MINISTRY - verses 35-41

A. JESUS CALMS A STORM.

1. Jesus doesn't cause storms – He leads us through them!

- 1 Peter 4:12-14 - *Beloved do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.*

2. Storms purify our faith.

- 1 Peter 1:7 - *So that the tested genuineness of your faith--more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire--may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.*

3. Jesus leads us through storms from inside the boat.

- Psalm 65:7 - *Who stills the roaring seas, the roaring of their waves, the tumult of the peoples*

B. JESUS IS THE EYE OF THE HURRICANE.

APPLICATION - HOW TO PREPARE FOR STORMS:

- **Be anchored in Scripture.**
- **Be cross focused.**
- **Be joined to the body of Christ**
