Jesus said to them, 'Fill the waterpots with water.' And they filled them up to the brim. And He said to them, 'Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast.' ... John 2:7-8 (NKIV)

"The Lord wants us to 'do whatever He tells' us. He often doesn't describe the path that He's taking us on. He doesn't explain how He intends to deal with our problems. 5. "You have kept the good wine until now"...

Scripture: John 2:9-12

- Not just Surviving (more old wine), but Thriving (new and better wine)...
 - <u>Luke 5:37-38</u>... "But new wine must be put into new wineskins, and both are preserved."
 - <u>Proverbs 3:9-10</u>... "And your vats will overflow with new wine."
 - John 2:11-12... "This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana...and His disciples believed in Him."

- 1. What stood out to you in tonight's message and scripture passages? Be descriptive...
- **2.** Reflecting on your life, are you anxious about anything? Is your prayer life bringing these petitions (both big and small) to the Lord? Remember <u>Matthew</u> 6:25-34 and <u>Philippians</u> 4:6-7.

- **3.** Jesus knew once He turned the water into wine, He began an irreversible journey that would lead to the cross, but bring about new life for us. **READ** *Romans* 6:1-11 and *Ephesians* 2:1-10.
 - So what are you going to do about it? Are you truly living like you have a New Life?
- **4**. What did you hear or learn from tonight's discussion that spoke to you personally? How will you directly and specifically apply it in your life today?
