"Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth." ...Revelation 3:10

Words of •"And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But the one who endures to the end will be saved." ~Matthew 10:22

- •More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope." ~Romans 5:3-4
- •God knows our situation; He will not judge us as if we had no difficulties to overcome. What matters is the sincerity and perseverance of our will to overcome them." ~C.S. Lewis
- Jesus does not reproach this congregation but condemns its persecutors. (Revelation 3:9).
- Christ promises that if Philadelphia's congregants remain faithful to Him, He will protect them from the "hour of trial" and make them pillars in God's heavenly temple (*Revelation 3:10-12*).
- 1. The Church in Philadelphia...The Church in History to Today...YOU!
 - The Church in <u>Ephesus</u>...a Love left behind (internal opposition)
 - The Church in <u>Smyrna</u>...Trials and Persecution (external opposition)
 - The Church in <u>Pergamos</u>...Their trap of Compromise (lowering standards)
 - The Church in <u>Thyatira</u>...Corrupt Tolerance (allowing sin)
 - The Church in <u>Sardis</u>...Spiritually Dead (relied on reputation from the past)

1. Compare the church of Smyrna to the church of Philadelphia. What are the similarities between the two? How are they different from the other five?

- 2. READ 2Corinthians 12:9-10 together... How can we as men have little strength and yet keep God's word? Describe a time when this has been the case for you...
- 3. In *Revelation 3:9* Jesus says He will make their persecutors fall at their feet and acknowledge God loves them. Describe a time when your stand for "truth" encountered opposition.
 - •How does it encourage you to know that God will acknowledge your faithfulness?
- 4. In *Revelation 3:12* Jesus says He will write three names on those who are victorious: the name of God, the name of God's city, and Christ's new name. At the cost of perseverance and endurance for the faith, what does it mean to you to be marked in this way?
