3. READ <u>Galatians 6:2 and Galatians 6:9-10, Hebrews 10:22-25, and 1Peter 4:7-11</u> together, ...stopping for a moment after each one to <u>discuss what is being said</u> and <u>how it is put into action in your own life</u>.
