1. Seeking Confirmation from the Lord... "Laying a Fleece"! Scripture: <u>Judges 6:36-40</u>

2. Influenced by the Good or the Bad... Letting God Choose what's Best! Scripture: <u>Judges 7:1-7</u>

3. God Blesses Our Obedience... *Trusting God to Increase our Confidence! Scripture: Judges 7:8-25*

4. Never Stand-Down... Finishing Strong! Scripture: <u>Judges 8</u>

- 1. We read a unique story in *Judges 6:36-40* how Gideon sought confirmation from the Lord regarding what the Lord had called him to do...often now referred to as a *"Fleece"*. The Lord knows of our own insecurities and lack of confidence or understanding...
 - How does this differ from actually doubting the Lord?
 - How can we rightly seek confidence or understanding in what the Lord is speaking to us today, while not doubting His word or His character? What would a "fleece" look like in your own life?

2. We are all influenced by things in our lives, and we are most influenced by whatever we give most of our attention to...primarily in these 3 areas in our life:

- Who you choose to spend time with...
- What <u>books</u> you read...
- The media and instruction/teaching you choose to watch/listen to the most...

Considering these 3 categories, <u>Who</u> (what people) and <u>What</u> (sources) are you choosing to be most influenced by in your own life? What needs to be removed from your life?

3. READ <u>Judges 7:4-7</u> together... All of the men mentioned were brave warriors who were willing to fight in spite of overwhelming odds...Men who responded courageously to the "Call to Action"...

• Why do you think God selected only 300 men out of the 10,000 who remained?

•What seemed to be different about the 300 men?

4. What stood out the most to you from tonight's message and/or discussion that you can apply to your life today?

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS (if there's time!)

1. How can we best respond (what should our attitude be) when we are not selected/chosen for the service we are willing to do?

2. How can we effectively "Course-Correct" when we realize the need for change, growth, and improvement in our lives?
