"But each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire he is dragged away and enticed. Then after desire has conceived it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full grown gives birth to death."

...James 1:14-15 (ESV)

1. Setting the Scene...David & Bathsheba

- ♦ The Progression of our Sins ... <u>James 1:14-15</u>
 - But each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire he is dragged away and enticed.
 - (David wanders out on the roof and sees Bathsheba);
 - Then after desire has conceived it gives birth to sin;
 - ◆ (David lusts after Bathsheba and sends for her);
 - "and sin, when it is full grown gives birth to death."
 - (David sleeps with Bathsheba)
- God Provides a Way of Escape from our Sins ... 1Corinthians 10:13, 2Peter 1:3-4

4. True Victory...The Spirit-Filled Life

- Read God's Word ... John 6:51
 - "I AM the Living Bread that comes down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever."
- Meditate ...<u>loshua 1:8</u>
 - (consider; contemplate; ponder, ruminate, weigh, think about deeply) ...on God's Word
- Pray / Worship<u>Matthew 6:6</u>
- Be Filled with the Spirit ... <u>Calatians 5:16</u>, <u>Galatians 5:22-23</u>, <u>Romans 8:1-2</u>

1. Last week we talked about "Conquering Life's Giants", as we learned from the story of when David faced and conquered the Philistine, Goliath, for challenging and defying the army of God (2Samuel 17). Through this discussion the question was asked, "Is there anything in your life that is intimidating you...that you are putting your faith in the circumstances or your ability to deal with it, rather than putting your faith completely in God and trusting Him through it?".

Have you given more thought to that question, and how have you applied the things you learned and/or discussed last week, ...what have been some of the noticeable results? ... Give Examples

- **2.** In today's scripture and message we learned of the serious and life-changing impact of sinful choices we make, and the destructive effect it has on our relationship with God, on the lives of those we love, and in our own lives. **As you think about the significance of this real story from 2** *Samuel 11...*
 - What is it that stands out to you...for the good or the bad?
 - Is there anything in David's story/life that you relate to?
 - •What can you learn from this story and this period of David's life...whether it's "what to do" or "what not to do"?
- **3.** READ <u>Psalm 139:23-24</u> together... Are there an choices, behaviors, or sin that you've been holding on to or keeping secret? ...be transparent, honest, and specific!

"Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!" Psalm 139:23-24 (ESV)
