How to Be a Man of God... Understand and Know!

1. Understand and Know... <u>Your Calling and Identity</u>! Scripture: <u>1Corinthians 1:2-3, Galatians 4:4-7, Titus 3:4-7</u>

2. Understand and Know... <u>the Gift You've been Given</u>! Scripture: <u>1Corinthians 1:4-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Matthew 5:16</u>

3. Understand and Know... <u>Your New DNA...Divine Nature Anointing</u>! Scripture: <u>2Peter 1:3-4</u>

4. Understand and Know... An Effective and Fruitful Life! Scripture: <u>2Peter 1:5-10</u>

5. What a Man of God Looks Like...Being a Man of God! Scripture: <u>1Corinthians 16:13-14</u> Strong Men/Legacy Makers ...

1. READ <u>2Titus 3:4-7 and Peter 1:3-4</u>... What does this tell you regarding what God has done for you, and the impact a growing relationship with the Lord Jesus has had/will have on your life?

• In what ways does this affect and change your perspective on life, your identity, and how you live?

2. READ <u>2Peter 1:5-7</u>... Write down and describe each of the qualities listed in these verses, and what each one means and looks like in a man's life.

•Why are these qualities essential for an effective and fruitful life? ...see Verses 8-10.

3. READ <u>1Corinthians 16:13-14</u>... Write down and describe each of the characteristics and qualities listed in these verses, and what each one means and looks like in a man's life.

4. What did you hear or learn from tonight's discussion that spoke to you personally? How will you directly and specifically apply it in your life today?

5. (*If you have extra time...*) READ <u>*Psalm 19*</u> together... What stands out to you the most, and speaks into your heart from this Psalm?be transparent, honest, and specific!

Take a few moments to share any Prayer Requests with the men in your Group. Write down any requests and commit to pray for one another throughout the week.

(It's great to know that other guys are praying for the important things in your life...and it's great to be praying for the important things in their lives!)
