Group Discussion

1. What stood out to you in tonight's message and scripture passages? ...*be descriptive!*
2. In what areas of your life do you have the hardest time completely *Trusting the Lord* and leaving things in His hands (*1Peter 5:7*)?
3. **READ Romans 12:1-2...** In verse 2 the word "renewal" literally means "Renovation". This verse tells us to not allow ourselves to be "conformed" to the world's standards and way of thinking...and that if we do not "conform", then God will "transform" our way of thinking and "renew", or "Renovate" our mindset as we choose to follow and obey Him in every part of our lives.
 - What kind of "Renovation" does your mind need?
 - In what areas does your way of thinking make it difficult for you to Trust the Lord completely?
4. **READ Proverbs 3:1-8** together... Describe the instruction that is given, and discuss the action(s) you can take to actively and practically apply this in your life *today!*
5. **READ Joshua 1:5-9...** The words that the Lord spoke to Joshua then, apply to us just the same now! What do you learn from this scripture and how can it apply to your life today?...
6. Is there anything from tonight's discussion that spoke to you personally? In what way(s) does it affect your life? How will you directly and specifically apply it in your life today?
