READ also <u>John 7:45-52</u>, John <u>19:38-42</u>, and also pay special attention to the way Nicodemus spoke to Jesus in <u>John 3:2</u>.

•What more do we learn about Nicodemus from these glimpses into who he was and what he did?

• How do you come to Jesus to spend time in His presence? ...regarding attitude, humility, and reverence, or as a "buddy"?

3. What did you hear or learn from tonight's episode and/or from seeing Jesus through His conversation with Nicodemus in *John 3:1-21* that would help you tell others about Jesus and who He is?

Take a few moments to share any Prayer Requests with the men in your Group. Write down any requests and commit to pray for one another throughout the week.
