4. Pay Attention to What He is Doing... Give Thanks!

Scripture... Colossians 4:2; Ephesians 5:20; Psalms 118:1; Hebrews 12:28

 - 5. What about Thankfulness? What happens when God blesses you and you neglect giving him the credit, the glory or a simple Thank you! Do you think that will affect the next time he's looking to bless you? Why or Why not?
 - 6. Is there anything from tonight's discussion that spoke to you personally? In what way(s) does it affect your life? How will you directly and specifically apply it in your life today?
