"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding" ...Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV)

"...Fear, ...awesome or terrifying thing, respect, reverence, and revered"

1. Scattered into the Wilderness... Eating, Drinking... and Playing

2. Exodus 15:22-25 and Psalms 1...

- The Bitter Waters of Worldly Wisdom: <u>Lust of Flesh</u>, <u>Lust of the Eyes</u>, and the <u>Pride of Life</u>...**1John 2:16**
- Bitters Waters (Worldly Wisdom)
 - Walking in the counsel of the ungodly
 - Standing with Sinners
 - <u>Sitting</u> with the scornful (Talks arrogantly or boasting)
- Living Waters (Godly Wisdom)
 - Prayer, Worship, Service, Fellowship, and God's Word!

3. You Shall Not Tempt the Lord...

■ <u>James 1:13-15...</u> "Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself temp anyone. But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death"

4. How do we Escape Sin and Temptation... Only through Christ!

- Walking as the man you were created be...an adopted son...
- Surrendered...
- Read the Word... Read the Word some more... and Re-Read the Word! He speaks to us through His Word!
- Don't just know it! ...APPLY IT!! ... Prayer, Worship, Service, Fellowship, and God's Word!
