

As you participate in the 40-Day Fast, please use this daily journal to reflect on the multitude of promises of God. There are over 7,000 promises in the Bible, so you can start with these, then let the Spirit lead you to find more! God's promises are meant to fuel your hope and inspire your faith. We pray that you will be blessed, encouraged, and strengthened as you pray through the promises of God.

A Note About Fasting:

Fasting is an individual, personal time between you and the Lord. Choose the fast that's best for you. While fasting means abstaining from food for most people, it can also be abstaining from something else to give you deeper time in prayer and fellowship with the Lord. Not everyone can fast from food, but if you give up something to focus on the Lord, that will be a meaningful fast.



Promise

After praying and seeking the Lord for my word of the year, the word PROMISE landed in my heart. I believe that God has promises He wants to fulfill in our lives.

Our church, Maranatha Chapel, has been on a journey this past year, processing grief, growing closer as a church family, and blessed to see God's faithfulness at work in our lives. When my dad left us for Heaven on January 4, 2022, it was like losing Moses, a great leader, pastor, and visionary who was excited to shepherd his people toward the Promised Land.

In Deuteronomy chapter 8, we find the Israelites camped along the banks of the Jordan river. They are finally ready to go in and take possession of the land, but Moses has some final words for them.

"Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep His commands. He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna...Your clothes did not wear out and your feet did not swell during these forty years."

When Moses described the wilderness as "a vast and dreadful place, full of venomous snakes and scorpions," I'm sure he got an "amen" from the people. The wilderness was a rocky, barren place where almost nothing lived, nothing grew, and nothing dwelt. A place they were happy to leave behind. Notice God





led them through the wilderness. It was never supposed to be their final destination.

Egypt was their past, and Canaan was their future, and in-between, was the wilderness. For us, the wilderness represents those in-between seasons of life. Maybe you feel like you're in one of those in-between places right now. In-between jobs. In-between relationships. You're not where you want to be. You feel barren.

But we are given promises from God.

We can't stay in the wilderness forever. We can't linger in the wilderness of grief or fear or whatever keeps us from moving forward. We need to press on and step into the rest of our stories.

The promises of God are like stepping stones; solid places we can put our feet, the rocks we can stand upon to prepare for the next step.

I love how Peter describes God's promises as "very great and precious." And there aren't just one or two. There are over 7,000. Each one is like a blank check made out to you personally and to all of us corporately as the body of Christ. These promises are meant to fuel your hope and inspire your faith.

But a check you haven't cashed won't do you any good.

So, we are setting aside this time to pray through the promises of God. Watch for what God is doing in your life. Rejoice when you see specific promises fulfilled.

It's time to stop wandering and possess God's promises for you!
